## JRTCA General Rules For Exhibitors

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Breeder's/Family, Open or Working Conformation.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation Division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes. If an Affiliate sponsored trial is chaired by Committee, all on the Committee may enter their Terriers in any phase of the competition.
9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by Stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier being shown in any class may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the Judge. These measurements will be considered the official height of the terrier in question. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Only JRTCA height cards issued AFTER September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground/Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.**
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655), or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website ([www.therealjackrussell.com](http://www.therealjackrussell.com)).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious diseases.**
- 23. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.**

## **DIVISION A: RACING**

**Begins promptly at 8:30 am ~ No Post Entries in Racing**

**All puppies will race in flats and hurdles, including Puppy Championships, then Seniors and then Adults**

ALL terriers must be muzzled to race with either a plastic basket or close-ended cloth muzzle. To be eligible in Championship, terriers must compete in both flats & hurdles. **You MUST have your Jack ON DECK and securely muzzled in order to race. If you need help, please ask for it in advance.** Please don't wait until it's time to load into the starting boxes!

- Class 31** **Adult Championship & Reserve 10" up to 12.5" (No entry fee)** Open to 1st place winners in classes 6, 8, 25 & 27.
- Class 32** **Adult Championship & Reserve over 12.5" up to 15" (No entry fee)** Open to 1st place winners in classes 7, 9, 26 & 28.
- Class 33** **Veteran Championship & Reserve 10" up to 12.5" (No entry fee)** Open to 1st place winners in classes 10 & 29.
- Class 34** **Veteran Championship & Reserve over 12.5" up to 15" (No entry fee)** Open to 1st place winners in classes 11 & 30.

## **DIVISION B: OBEDIENCE (New Equipment)**

**8:30 am – 11:00 am – Go Texan Building**

**TERRIERS MUST BE AT LEAST 1 YEAR OLD**

**All participants must be judged within this time period. If you have a conflict, please bring it to Chairperson's attention before 8:00 am. All participating terriers will be judged on obedience mats in heeling pattern, long sit, long down.**

**NO EXCEPTIONS**

**YOU MUST BE ON TIME FOR YOUR CLASS IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE!**

- Class 35** **Sub-Novice (8:30 am)** Ten maximum in each group; all commands on leash. To be judged individually: heel, heel figure 8, stand for exam, recall. Honor sit or down while the next Exhibitor does on-lead heeling.
- Class 36** **Novice (9:00 am)** To be judged individually: heel on-leash, figure 8, stand for exam, heel off-leash, recall off-leash. Honor sit or down, while the next heeling pattern is done.
- Class 37** **Open (9:30 am)** To be judged individually: heel free, figure 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high jump and board jump. To be judged as a group: 3-minute long sit, 5-minute long down.
- Class 44** **Youth Handler Obedience - See Youth Division D.**
- Class 38** **Obedience High Point & High Point Reserve** (Non-sanctioned & no entry fee) To be awarded to the highest score in classes **35, 36 and 37**. Most advanced class breaking tie.

## **DIVISION C: RALLY OBEDIENCE DIVISION (New Equipment)**

- Class 39** **Companion Rally** Open to any adult terrier. Performed on-lead. May be same course as Rally I. This class is for the companion terrier that has little or no formal Obedience training. A true beginner class. May not cross-enter Rally I or Rally II.
- Class 40** **Rally I.** Open to any adult terrier. Performed on-lead. Numbered course of 1-15 signs. Performed on loose lead at a normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. May cross-enter into Rally II.
- Class 41** **Rally II.** Open to any adult terrier. Performed off-lead. Numbered course of 15-18 signs. Course the same as Rally I with different or added exercises of more difficulty. May cross-enter into Rally I.

## **DIVISION D: YOUTH**

- Class 42** **Child Handler – Immediately following Working Terrier Grand Entry**  
Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.
- Class 43** **Youth Handler – Immediately following Child Handler**  
Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a JRT, one year of age or older. Judged on the Youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the JRT. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.
- Class 44** **Youth Handler Obedience (8:30 am in Go Texan Building)**  
Open to any youth aged 10 through 16. Judged as the Sub-Novice Obedience Class. All commands on-leash. Judged on the ability of the Youth to present his/her dog and knowledge of Obedience.
- Class 45** **Youth Handler Agility (On-Lead)** - Open to any youth aged 10 through 16. To be run over the Novice Agility course. Time not to be considered. Judged on the youth's ability to handle the terrier and knowledge of Agility.
- Class 46** **Youth Go To Ground** - Immediately after Obedience - Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a JRT. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through the 10 ft. novice liner. Time **NOT** to be considered. ***If the terrier***

*is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before It can compete in Youth GTG.*

**Class 47 Youth Handler High Score & Reserve** – Awarded to the highest scoring Youth and runner-up in classes 43-46.
